

Focusing on Merleau-Pontyâ ™s later writings, including unpublished course notes and documents not yet available in English, Carbone demonstrates both that Merleau-Pontyâ TMs interest in film was sustained and philosophically crucial, and also that his thinking provides an important resource for illuminating our contemporary relationship to images, with profound implications for the future of philosophy and aesthetics.
