

I have tried many different types of thesaurus (?) in my classroom. This one is easy for the students to read, and I like the related words section. My students use it on a regular basis. It's perfect for upper elementary.

Great for getting kids started in looking up words, finding words and alphabetizing. Missing a few words we deem essential, but it should be essential to be able to look words up by book not just google.

As a homeschool Mom, I needed to purchase a thesaurus for my 10 year old. This is one purchase that I don't regret buying! The quality is excellent and my 10 year old is able to use it on her own with no troubles! I will be buying her the updated ones each year because I'm so impressed!

For writers workshop having access to a good thesaurus can be rewarding and entertaining for kids. I like using them with kids to focus on all the parts we observe in funny pictures or with little pieces of nature brought into the classroom or from a high quality photograph from a good non fiction book.

I have 6 more children this year that would have been without these. We use them for our 5 day writing program. Wednesday is revising day and the children use red pens to revise overused boring words with the help of thesauruses. The children learn to replace boring words with more sophisticated vocabulary.

I purchase these books for an elementary school donation every year. Always happy with them, and so are the students.

I bought this for my 1st-3rd grade classroom.
