

So, if I loved a poem that I wanted to share with someone else who has the book, how will I refer to it? Very unprofessional book publishing in my opinion. I don't think I would recommend this book to a friend unless they were just starting out reading poetry and hadn't been online reading any of the beautiful "unknown" writers on social media. It was a let down for me. I preferred Warsan Shire's poetry, although the price of her book was criminal, considering the page numbers (borrow it if you can).
