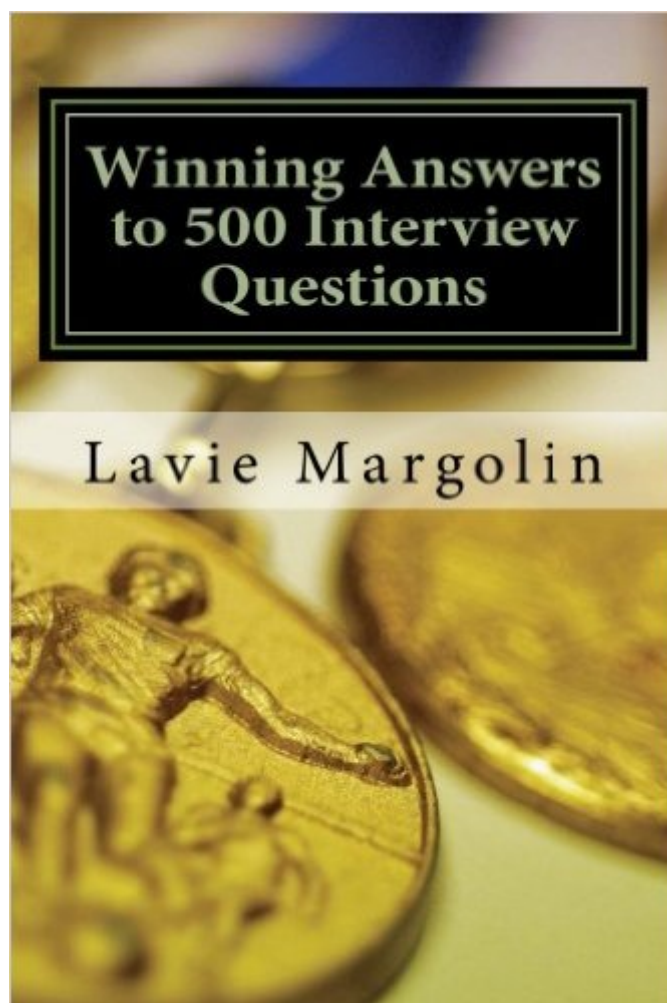

I had been unemployed for almost a year when I picked up Winning Answers to 500 Interview Questions. I had been on a lot of interviews of many different types: structured, unstructured, panel, one-on-one, test based, interview based, phone, with recruiters, with managers, with consultants, etc. After a while the interviews begin to blend together. While I started off really preparing for each one, eventually I was just relying on my skills answering questions to get through the processes. One day a friend handed me this book. I immediately recognized many of the questions that were in the book as ones that I had gotten on interviews. I also saw a bunch that I was glad that I hadn't been asked. The book gives a concise way of approaching questions: categorizing them based on intent and answering them in such a way that really moves the interview in the direction that I want it to be going. One major way that the book helped me was that I would review questions on my way to an interview. Not that I expected to be asked the specific questions I was reviewing, but it would get me into the mindset of answering a certain type of question a certain way. For early morning or late afternoon interviews especially, it became a necessary tool to get me focused and

ready to rock an interview. Before I was using the book in this way it was sometimes hard for me to get into the mood to be interviewed especially after I had gone on a lot of interviews (sometimes for the same job) and was pretty sick of the process. End of the story, I eventually got the right job. Interestingly, the interview that finally did it was the one that asked questions that were the most similar to the types of questions that this book prepared me to answer. I highly recommend it.

I am very glad that New York Times author Lavie Margolin's latest book, "Winning Answers to 500 Interview Questions," compiling knowledge acquired from speaking with career professionals, job seekers, and hiring managers over the last 10 years, and grounded in the reality of what employers are seeking, is now available. What this book remarkably contains is a comprehensive compendium of typical real-life questions, and for each, a better understanding of each question's context and subtext: * Why the interviewer is asking each question; * The strategy involved in responding; and * A sample answer that you can tailor for yourself, and practice. There are reasons Lavie Margolin's effectively conveyed practical guidance on how to proceed has earned publication in the New York Times, Wall Street Journal, CNN.com; and all over the place elsewhere, particularly on LinkedIn (including "Lavie Margolin's Lion Cub Job Search"). "Winning Answers to 500 Interview Questions" delivers exactly what it promises. A WIN. Google the topic "Tough Interview questions" (or words to that extent). Compile a challenge list from as many of them as you'd like. He's already thought of them, and gave a better answer than the one you're holding. Simply and straightforward, Lavie breaks down almost any question you could think of, in ways you can relate to, and helps to give you the confidence you need, and see the knowledge you already have, to tackle anything thrown your way during the interview. If you have concerns about your interview skills, and DON'T pick up don't pick up a copy, you may find yourself asking a question no one can answer: "Why not?"

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
