

Synopsis

As we come to the end of the century, the entire vista of modern poetry has dramatically changed. Poet-editors Jerome Rothenberg and Pierre Joris provide informative and irreverent commentaries throughout. They challenge old truths and propose alternative directions, in the tradition of the revolutionary manifestos that have marked the art and poetry of the twentieth century. The result is both an essential source book for experiencing the full range of this century's poetic possibilities and a powerful statement on the future of poetry in the millennium ahead.

This is an excellent alternative to the standard anthology of Romantic writings It includes more female authors of the era, such as Mary Robinson, an Asian "gallery", American authors such as Whitman, Melville, Dickinson and a generous sampling of continental authors. Romanticism is apprehended as a movement from the mid-1700s to late 1800s. I would have included more of Percy Shelley, Robert Browning and other "strong" poets as opposed to the ideological cast of the book. Still in all, a useful effort.
